1. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest.

2. MOTION TO EXCLUDE THE PUBLIC UNDER SECTION 100(A)(4) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972

RESOLVED THAT- under Section 100(A) (4) of the Local Government Act 1972 the public be excluded from the meeting for the following items on the grounds that they involve the likely disclosure of information defined in paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 12A of the Act.

3. APPLICATION FOR A NEW HACKNEY CARRIAGE VEHICLE LICENCE

The Sub-Committee considered the contents of a private report of the Head of Environment and Public Realm (Part 2 - Agenda Item 1) concerning an application for the grant a new Hackney Carriage Vehicle Licence to white Peugeot Premier registration number SF13 FWK.

The Sub-Committee viewed the proposed vehicle in the presence of the applicant and his representative prior to the meeting. Both the applicant and his representative attended the hearing and addressed the Sub-Committee.

The Sub-Committee considered the report presented by the Principal Licensing Officer, further information provided by the Principal Licensing Officer and the applicant in answer to questions of the Sub-Committee.

Having considered the details of the application and heard all the evidence available, the Sub-Committee;

RESOLVED TO – grant vehicle SF13 FWK a hackney carriage vehicle licence on condition that prior to the issue of the licence the following requirements are met:

- (1) the repair or replacement of the front passenger seat;
- (2) repair of the tailgate;
- (3) the verification of the vehicle's current mileage; and
- (4) production of up-to-date hackney carriage vehicle insurance.

4. APPLICATION FOR A NEW HACKNEY CARRIAGE VEHICLE LICENCE

The Committee considered the private report of the Head of Environment and Public Realm (Part 2 - Agenda Item 2) concerning an application for a new Hackney Carriage Vehicle Licence for a replacement vehicle.

The vehicle was not available for inspection due to its location, however further detailed information about the condition and history of the vehicle was provided to the Sub-Committee by the Principal Licensing Officer, which had been obtained after the publication of the report.

The Applicant attended the hearing and answered questions posed by the Sub-Committee.

Having considered the details of the application and heard all the evidence available, the Sub-Committee;

RESOLVED TO – grant a hackney carriage vehicle licence to Peugeot Partner Tepee, registraion SF16 FZ, subject to the vehicle successfully completing the normal vehicle inspections and documentary application process.
